## Introduction of Regional Energy Concepts

The project **Introduction of Regional Energy Concepts** (CEP-REC) has the target to support the use of renewable energy sources and increase energy efficiency in Central Europe.

As the use of renewable energy sources has to be implemented mainly on the regional level, the regions are key actors in this development. Regional Energy Concept bring many chances for a good development of renewable energies and energy efficiency.

### Regional Energy Concepts:

- show the present situation as baseline inventory
- show the potentials for the use of renewable energies and energy efficiency in the region
- help to identify barriers for the future development
- bring the chance to involve the stakeholders and the population in the process
- include a strategy and an action plan ready to apply for the region
- make the different regions comparable
- are a base to exchange knowledge between the regions

Within the project CEP-REC Regional Energy Concepts will be elaborated for nine pilot regions in the eight countries from the Central Europe Programme.

Between the pilot regions there are many differences at the start. Some countries and regions are already very experienced and far developed in the field of renewable energies, while others start on a very low level.

The project partners will share their experience and knowledge to learn from each other. As there are different methodologies in use in the different countries another target of the project is to develop a common methodology for the elaboration of a Regional Energy Concept with all its different steps.

Finally a joint transnational strategy will show the way into the future.



## Activities in the Pilot Regions

In each pilot region a Regional Energy Concept will be elaborated in the following steps:

- Assessment and Mapping of the energy demand in the pilot regions, including baseline data
- Assessment and Mapping of the energy supply in the pilot regions
- Assessment of the existing potentials for RES in each pilot region
- Comparison of the baseline situations in each pilot region
- Assessment of energy transfer potential
- Elaboration of Regional Energy Balance Sheets for the pilot regions
- Development path of the region
- Joint strategy and energy action plan
