For the energy turnaround, regions are playing a very important role.

Cities and communities implement the energy turnaround locally, while on federal and state level important framework conditions are set. However, their initial energetic situation varies greatly.

The best basis for an implementation is a local energy concept, which serves as a starting point for different projects and activities. For assistance, the international project "Introduction of Regional Energy Concepts" (CEP-REC) was initiated within the frame of the CENTRAL EUROPE Programme Interreg IV B.

It supported the elaboration of regional energy concepts in nine central European regions under the Lead Partnership of Energy and Environmental Centre Allgaeu (eza!).

During the international closing conference "Regional Energy Concepts – Basis for the success of regional and municipal energy policy" examples and results from the Regional Energy Concepts are presented. In the afternoon working groups will discuss specific issues on concept elaboration. Moreover, there will be the opportunity for an exchange of experiences among stakeholders from participating regions.

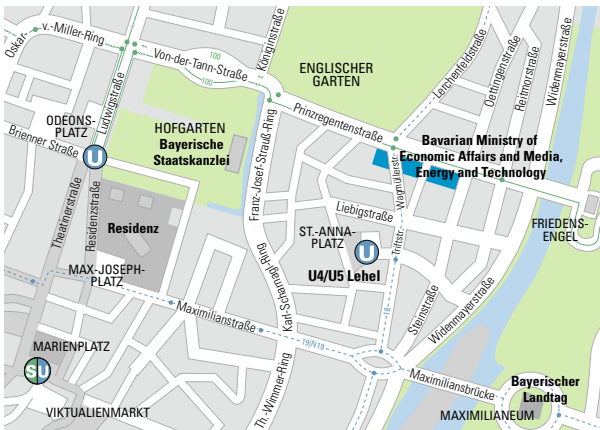
